

## RoHS Compliance Statement

### Restriction of the use of certain Hazardous Substances

This statement clarifies Zoleo Inc.'s compliance with European Union Directive 2015/863/EU on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment ("RoHS") that took effect on June 4, 2015. The RoHS Directive restricts the sale of electronic equipment containing the following hazardous substances in the European Union:

- Cadmium(Cd): 0.01%
- Mercury: 0.1%
- Lead(Pb) : 0.1%
- Hexavalent chromium (Cr6+) : 0.1%
- Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB): 0.1 %;
- Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE): 0.1 %
- Bis(2-Ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP): 0.1% (added in 2015);
- Benzyl butyl phthalate (BBP): 0.1% (added in 2015);
- Dibutyl phthalate (DBP): 0.1% (added in 2015);
- Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP): 0.1% (added in 2015)

Zoleo Inc. certifies that all products comply with the environmental standards set forth by the Directive 2015/863/EU (known as RoHS 3), the recast amendment of RoHS Directive 2011/65/EU Article(4), (RoHS 2) and do not contain any of the above-mentioned, 10 hazardous substances above the specified limits. All products manufactured by Zoleo Inc. are RoHS-compliant.
